# Bulb Pre-export Inspection – Notes

## Exporter

- The applicant's name, address and signature must be shown on every form.
- Columns 1 and 2 must be completed i.e. Grower's name, Stock No. (from GSI report)\*, weight of stock presented for inspection, list of countries you wish to export to by code (i.e. A, B, D or O) and date of soil sampling and PCN Code.

\*If a stock number has not been allocated then use the plant passport number.

- A charging form must be completed for each day's pre-export inspections, unless authority has already been given by the exporter for charging for services provided for the current financial year.
- When completed, all copies of the form should be given to Fera Plant Health and Seeds Inspectors **before** inspections can take place.
- If you require advice concerning export regulations, please consult your local Fera Plant Health and Seeds Inspectors.

## Data Protection Act 1998

- Information provided will be used for the processing of your application. It can also be used to determine the eligibility of your crops for export. Details will be held in our computer system and may be used to compile statistics on activity in your sector and to inform Fera Plant Health and Seeds Inspectors, Defra, other Government Departments or their appointed agents of the location of crops in emergency situations, such as pest outbreak. It may also be used by Fera for scientific research.
- Fera may be required to release information, including personal data and commercial information, on request under the Environmental Information Regulations, the Code of Practice on Access to Government Information or the Freedom of Information Act 2000. However, Fera will not permit any unwarranted breach of confidentiality nor will we act in contravention of our obligations under the Data Protection Act 1998.
- Fera or its appointed agents may use the name, address and other details on your application form to contact you in connection with occasional customer research aimed at improving the services that Fera provides to you.
